For those returning students the list below will be familiar. For all students new to AISZ middle school, this list contains the school supplies requested by the core subject teachers. Most all of these items will be available for purchase in local stores. Please contact any Middle School teacher if you are having problems locating these items. **General supplies each student should have on a daily basis include:**

For any subject not specifically listed, the teacher will discuss their requirements on the first day of school. Generally speaking, students should have lined paper in either a notebook or binder for these subjects. It should also be noted that within the first few days, specialist teachers might have additional requests for supplies. They will, of course, give appropriate time for students to purchase them.
