1 SCOPE OF THE TENDER AND OBJECTIVE

The American International School in Zagreb (AISZ) announces a tender for the collection of bids for the provision of hygiene maintenance services for the school internal and external areas of the school.

AISZ is located in Zagreb, Damira Tomljanovića Gavrana 3.

The current enrollment of the school is 350 students, ranging from Pre-Kindergarten (age 3) to Grade 12th (age 19) and we employ 89 faculty and staff.

Our school community is made up of different nationalities representing more than forty countries.

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (**RFP**) is to select a company that will perform the cleaning tasks defined in this tender, with the possibility that AISZ contract with the selected tenderer may be changed to a smaller scope or job description before signing, with previously agreed conditions.

The tenderer is obliged to provide a sufficient number of professional staff so that the requested jobs are carried out in a way that does not disturb the normal functioning of the school and the teaching process.

The tenderer is obliged to provide employees to perform all the tasks defined in the tender and subsequently signed contract, between 3:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

Cleaning will be organized during the school days according to annual School Calendar. Specific dates can be changed and increased based on the need of the AISZ during the year. At the end of each school holiday, it is necessary to clean the school and prepare it for the arrival of students. General cleaning should be performed during the summer break, end of July and beginning of August as agreed with the AISZ.

The tenderer must comply with the contents and conditions of the RFP when making the offer and applying for the tender.

The tenderer must present references proving that he meets the criteria and requirements stated in this offer.

2 OBLIGATIONS OF THE CLEANING COMPANY

The tendered is obliged to provide:

- Sufficient number of staff for:
 - daily cleaning of the school after school, between 3:00 PM and 9:00 PM (minimum 180 days)
 - o cleaning of the school on the last day of school holidays and before classes resume
 - general cleaning of the school during July and August between 8:00 AM and 4:00
 PM
 - o cleaning on weekends after competitions and additional school activities
- To inform AISZ prior to hire/change of employees and complete security controls.
 - o Criminal record
 - ID card photocopy
 - Signed Statement of Suitability
 - Child Safeguarding training and acknowledgment of Code of Conduct (provided by AISZ)

Cleaning company is responsible for all employees who are working for them. The cleaning company will cover employee's food, transportation and health expenses.

Cleaning company will require a friendly, service-oriented attitude from its employees.

Cleaning company is responsible for the payment of all taxes and contributions for the employees.

The Cleaning Company will be responsible for any medical expenses for their employees, caused by occupational/health hazards.

HYGIENE MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS

All equipment that is used in the regular work of the cleaning company, for example a floor washing machine, vacuum cleaners or any device, is provided by the cleaning company.

The cleaning company is responsible for the maintenance of the equipment provided by the cleaning company, and AISZ cannot be responsible for rent, maintenance or any costs related to the equipment provided by the cleaning company. AISZ will provide storage area for the equipment.

AISZ undertakes the supply of its cleaning materials (chemicals, sponges, cloths and other small materials used for cleaning), paper goods (toilet paper, paper towels) and odors in sanitary areas.

The cleaning company is obliged to provide its employees with protective equipment prescribed by the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

3 LIST OF HYGIENE MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR INDOORS AND ACCESS AREAS AROUND THE SCHOOL

CAFETERIA*, LOBBY AND CORRIDORS:

*includes serving area

Daily:

- gathering, sorting and disposing of waste in containers
- removing trash from waste bins
- removing dust and fingerprints from furniture surfaces, glass surfaces, mirrors, doors, architraves and door handles
- mechanical damp wiping of ceramic floors
- vacuuming textile floor coverings
- cleaning doormats at entrances
- cleaning fingerprints from glass doors and panels around which is the most common reach (e.g. around door handles and at the height of a child's reach in the kindergarten areas)
- Tables in cafeteria needs to be cleaned and wiped

Weekly:

- cobweb removal
- wiping windowsills
- cleaning switches and sockets
- damp wiping radiators and radiator pipes
- cleaning doors and architraves
- vacuuming textile parts of furniture
- cleaning picture frames, fire extinguishers and other fixtures
- watering plants

Monthly:

- cleaning hard to reach surfaces of cupboards and other fixtures
- removing fingerprints from wall cladding
- removing dust from plants
- cleaning the entrance door, glass walls at the main entrance and at the exit to the terrace from the dining room, from the floor without using ladders or scaffolding
- cleaning the full height of the glass doors inside the School

CLASSROOMS, OFFICES

Daily:

- gathering, sorting and disposing of waste in containers
- emptying wastepaper boxes
- removing trash from waste bins
- removing dust and fingerprints from furniture surfaces, glass surfaces, doors, architraves and door handles
- damp wiping the surfaces of desks and chairs
- vacuuming linoleum floors
- vacuuming textile floor coverings

As needed:

• damp wiping or cleaning floors in classrooms

Weekly:

- damp cleaning of linoleum floors (after wiping the tables, lifting chairs onto the tables)
- cleaning picture frames, fire extinguishers and other fixtures
- cobweb removal
- wiping windowsills
- cleaning switches and sockets
- wiping clear desk surfaces
- cleaning office chairs

Monthly:

- cleaning hard to reach surfaces of cupboards and other fixtures
- removing dust from plants

HALLS WITH SPORTS FLOORS (PARQUETRY)

Daily:

- dry sweeping areas with appropriate mops
- wiping benches and furniture inside the hall

As needed:

- damp wiping or cleaning parquetry floors
- cleaning of bleachers

SANITARY FACILITIES AND SPORTS CHANGING ROOMS

Daily:

- emptying waste bins and disposing in container
- cleaning toilets, sinks, urinals and ceramic tiles in close proximity
- cleaning shower spaces and tiles in close proximity
- cleaning mirrors, shelves and lighting above mirrors
- cleaning sanitary equipment (toilet paper holders, soap trays, toilet brushes)
- removing fingerprints from furniture and doors
- placing toiletries
- damp wiping of floor surfaces

Weekly:

- cobweb removal
- cleaning waste bins
- wiping windowsills

Monthly:

- cleaning ceramic tiles
- cleaning doors
- cleaning lighting fixtures

KITCHENETTES

Daily:

- emptying waste bins, removing and disposing of garbage in containers
- wiping tables (top surfaces)
- cleaning and wiping the kitchen equipment (kettles, microwave, toaster, etc)
- cleaning wash tubs, armature and ceramic tiles (in close proximity to the tubs)
- removal of fingerprints from refrigerators, furniture and doors
- damp wiping or vacuuming floor surfaces
- gathering dishes and washing in a dishwasher

Weekly:

- cobweb removal
- cleaning waste bins
- wiping windowsills

Monthly:

- cleaning ceramic tiles
- cleaning doors
- cleaning refrigerators

STAIRCASES, ELEVATORS, STAIRS

Daily:

- removing fingerprints for all external and internal parts of the elevators
- damp wiping stair treads in the main hall area
- damp wiping floor surfaces
- removing fingerprints from glass parts and glass handrail
- vacuuming the door tracks of lifts

Weekly:

- cobweb removal
- damp cleaning elevators
- damp cleaning stair treads in secondary walking surfaces

Yearly:

• 2x thorough cleaning of elevators

TECHNICAL AREAS Sprinkler station, machine room, etc.

- 1x monthly sweeping and damp wiping of floor surfaces
- 1x monthly cobweb removal
- 1x annually damp wiping equipment, pipes and channels

OUTSIDE PARKING LOT, PLAYGROUND, YARD AND SPORTS FIELDS

Daily:

- emptying waste bins
- gathering bulky waste and disposing in appropriate containers
- sweeping the paved parts of access path in front of the entrance to the School

Weekly:

- sweeping pavements around the School buildings
- sweeping terraces and balconies

Monthly:

• sweeping parking areas

DEEP CLEANING / GENERAL CLEANING

Deep cleaning shall be performed once or twice a year, by arrangement with the AISZ.

Deep cleaning, apart from the tasks set out in the daily, weekly and monthly description, also includes a thorough cleaning of hard to reach places, indoor and outdoor cleaning of all glass surfaces and facades up to 3 meters in height.

For cleaning glass surfaces and facades above 3 meters, AISZ will engage an external company.

4 FINANCIAL TERMS

- Contract period will be 2 years with a probation period of 6 months. Both parties can cancel the agreement with prior notice of 2 (two) months. Contract will be renewable on an annual basis unless parties cancel 2 (two) months in advance
- The agreed price will be calculated per hour of each employee for cleaners up to 6 hours per day, in accordance with the hours actually spent, which will be recorded by AISZ and cleaning company.
- The price of an individual employee must include the costs of all machinery, equipment and tools necessary for the quality fulfillment of the contract

5 FORCE MAJEURE

 In the event of Force Majeure which is independent of the will of the Parties, (war, an act of terrorism, nuclear explosion, radioactive or chemical contamination, pandemic, natural disasters, etc.) that would require to change the way of performing the activities, Cleaning company will adjust activity performance according to AISZ request in order to provide safety to all users.
